Codi Felt Information

Technical Properties

100% polyester. This fleece is molded in a controlled manufacturing process with heat and pressure in a press tool and then cut cleanly in its contour. The mottled polyester fleece consists of fibers in different colors. Minor color differences and lighter foreign fibers may occur.

The Codi felt shell is odorless, solvent-free, and emission-free. It retains hardly any electrostatic charge.

Routine Maintenance

To maintain the beautiful look of the felt shell for as long as possible, we recommend regular cleaning with the upholstery nozzle of your vacuum cleaner. After vacuuming, we recommend the use of a cleaning glove, dampened slightly with distilled water to wipe the shell. Continued care on a regular basis will ensure the continued beauty of the felt shell.

Spot Cleaning and Stain Treatment

Always remove dirt immediately. If possible, remove dry dirt on the surface with a soft brush or cloth. Use a synthetic fiber cleaning agent to remove dirt.

- Cover a soft brush with a cleaning cloth and spray a synthetic fiber cleaning agent on the cloth.
- Treat the stain with circular movements. Repeat if necessary.
- In case of strong dirt accumulation or old stains, spray the cleaning agent directly on the stain and treat the stain again with the cloth and brush.
- You should finish cleaning the felt shell by wiping down with a clean cloth, dampened with distilled water.

In case of excessive dirt accumulation, you can let the cleaning agent absorb for a minimum of five minutes and clean the area with a professional spray extraction machine. You can repeat this process several times.

Pretreat lipstick stains with a solution of mild detergent and tepid water.

Under no circumstances should you ever use aggressive, solvent-based, or abrasive cleaning agents. Always test any cleaner on a concealed spot to avoid discoloration or damaging the material.
